<b>Background and Objectives</b>	Topic is introduced in a manner that is appropriate for non-experts.
	Provide context for work.
	Research questions or objectives are clearly communicated.
<b>Methods/Medium and Results</b>	Methods are logically presented.
	Rationale for each technique.
	Clear relationship between objectives and results.
<b>Impacts</b>	Work is novel or impactful.
	Implications and applications of the work.
	Future avenues of investigation are identified.
<b>Visual Presentation</b>	Figures and images are visually engaging.
	Poster lay-out flows logically.
	Poster's content is error-free.
<b>Communication Skills</b>	Presenter speaks clearly, naturally, and with enthusiasm.
	Makes frequent eye contact.
	Presentation is well-paced and appropriate length.
<b>Questions</b>	Answers questions clearly, thoroughly, and succinctly.
	Understands and addresses audience's questions.
	Can integrate knowledge to answer questions.
