Methods/Medium and Results	Methods are logically presented.

	Clear relationship between objectives and results.
Impacts	Work is novel or impactful.
	Implications and applications of the work.
	Future avenues of investigation are identified.
Visual Presentation	Figures and images are visually engaging.
	Poster lay-out flows logically.
	Poster's content is error-free.
Communication Skills	Presenter speaks clearly, naturally, and with enthusiasm.
